

# Mountain Bike Racks Ready For Distribution



17 Bike Racks located at the Conservation District Yard - 360 Lincoln Street in Caliente are ready for distribution. The Bike Racks were constructed by the Lincoln County High School Welding Class, supervised by their teacher Tyler Heaton and consultant Keith Comella.

The funding for this project comes from the Nevada Commission On Tourism (NCOT), the Caliente Room Tax Board, and the Lincoln County Room Tax Board.



A previous solicitation last spring provided 3 bike racks for Kershaw Ryan State Park, 3 bike racks for the City of Caliente, 2 bike racks for the Pioche Town Board, and 1 bike rack for the Overland Hotel and Saloon. Those commitments will be met, leaving 8 bike racks for other parts of Lincoln County.

The price for these bike racks are as follows:

- Bike Racks – Free
- Bike Racks with Tools - \$127.51
- Bike Racks with Bike Pumps - \$151.78
- Bike Racks with both Tools and Bike Pumps - \$279.29
